WATERWAYS INFORMATION BULLETIN

General Information

To ensure the safety of the Detroit River Waterway users, the U. S. Coast Guard has enacted a special local regulation, published in the Federal Register and advertised by Local and Broadcast Notice to Mariners. U.S. Coast Guard, U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary and law enforcement vessels will be patrolling the regulated area.

Area Closed to Mariners

The U.S. Waters of the Detroit River will be closed between the Ambassador Bridge and the western tip of Belle Isle on Tuesday, August 23rd 2011 from 8:00 AM until 3:00 PM. Traffic will be restricted to conduct a U.S. Coast Guard exercise. Vessels will not be allowed to enter, transit through, or anchor within the regulated area without permission of the Coast Guard Patrol Commander, Station Belle Isle, which may be contacted on channel 16 VHF-FM.
