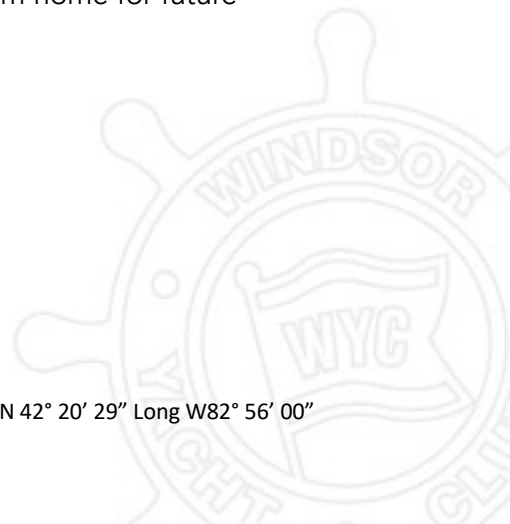

Marina Map:

Dock staff are available to assist you during the following hours:

Sunday: 10:00 am – 8:00 pm

Monday: 10:00 am – 6:00 pm

Tuesday - Saturday: 9:00 am – 8:30 pm

Please note that attended dock hours may vary at the boating season's beginning (April) and end (October). To reach the Dock staff, you can contact them on Channel 68.



Marina Rules and Regulations (selected):

All visiting yacht club Members in good standing of a reciprocal yacht club are welcome to moor their boats and enjoy the facilities of the Windsor Yacht Club. Reservations are required and will be accepted on an as-available basis.

High Season: Victoria Day weekend through Labour Day weekend inclusive

Off-Season: November 1st through March 31st.

Low Season: Between High and Off Seasons

High Season, out-of-club transients \$2.00 per foot per night, three nights maximum

Low Season, out-of-club transients are \$2.00 per foot per night for three nights, reducing to \$1.00 per foot per night afterward.

Refilling portable and removable gas tanks must occur off the property. The transfer of fuel between containers is strictly prohibited within WYC premises. Additionally, fixed tanks should be kept from being refueled dockside. Storage of gasoline or combustible materials in the dock areas is not allowed.

Dinghies should be stowed in a manner that does not hinder or obstruct the safe movement of other people or vessels.

Boats must be positioned to avoid obstructing the main dock walkways. To ensure unobstructed pathways, walkways should always remain clear of water hoses, electrical cords, dock boxes, and overextended bow-sprits. For safety reasons, running on the docks is not permitted.

The Club bears no responsibility for any damages caused, regardless of the cause.

Visiting boaters are permitted to **fish** only from 6:00 am to 11:00 am, and the designated fishing area is exclusively the Pier located just east of the patio. No other regions within the harbour are allowed for fishing.

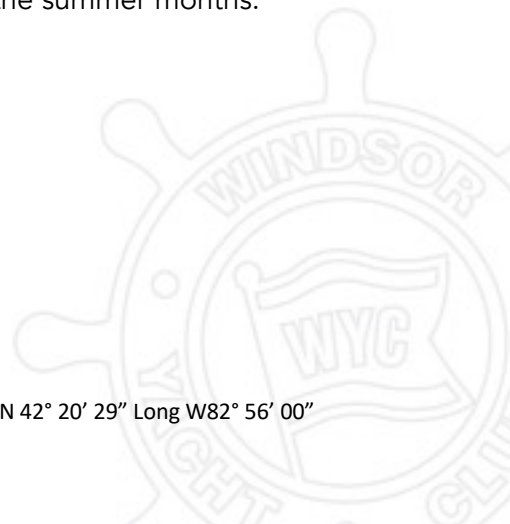
Ice is available for visiting boaters in the clubhouse during normal business operations. Please see the Dock staff.

Swimming Pool Policies / Rules - **A list of pool rules** is displayed in the pool area. Please abide by these rules.

We value the peaceful and enjoyable atmosphere for all our members and guests. We have established designated **quiet hours** within the harbour after 11 PM. During these hours, we kindly request everyone's cooperation in maintaining a tranquil environment, ensuring minimal noise levels.

Club Facilities and Amenities:

Our clubhouse features a long-standing reputation for its casual and fine dining experiences and the convivial warmth of its bar-side ambience. We pride ourselves on being an active supporter of local talent and have a busy roster of live music that represents a variety of styles and genres, especially on Friday nights and Sunday afternoons during the summer months. Come out and enjoy the music.



In addition to its full-service clubhouse and 158 serviced boat wells, the Windsor Yacht Club also provides the following:

- Green Acres picnic area: a covered gazebo with a barbecue located at the south end of the West Harbour
- Shantytown: Poolside tented seating with weather protection and gas barbecue located at the south end of the East Harbour by the pool
- Riverside picnic area: large, covered seating area with barbecue and river views located on the river on the north side of the Riverside Harbour
- Swimming pool with a lounging area located behind Shantytown
- Newly renovated poolside bathrooms and showers
- Riverfront seating area, perfect for watching sunsets
- Extensive parking
- Security video monitoring of all exterior areas

Two showers and restrooms are available 24/7 immediately adjacent to the pool on the East Harbour. Access code: 324

Windsor Yacht Club does not have laundry facilities onsite. The closest laundromat is Super Clean Laundromat, located at 2675 Lauzon Rd, Windsor, ON N8T 2Z5 – less than a five-minute Uber ride.

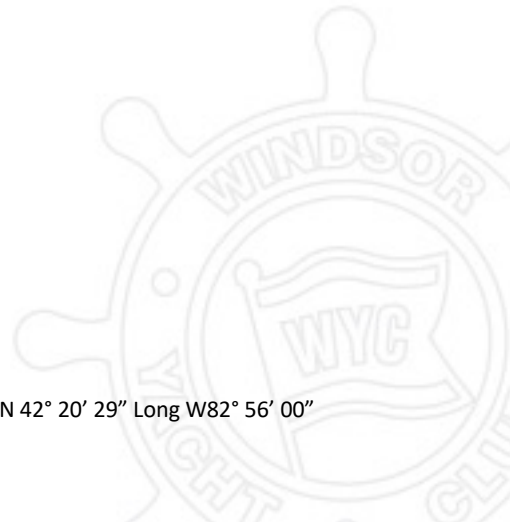

Clubhouse Rules and Regulations (selected):

The Windsor Yacht Club is a private club for the exclusive use of its Members. Members of recognized yacht clubs that have visiting arrangements with our Club shall be allowed the privileges of the clubhouse after having registered, so long as they abide by the Club rules.

Every visitor's name must be entered in the Register provided in the front lobby.

The Club staff shall not be subject to reprimand, interference, or harassment by any member or visitor.

Pets are strictly prohibited inside the clubhouse or any licensed service area inside or outside, except registered Service Animals, and must always be on a leash when on the property. Please clean up after your pet.

All food or beverages consumed on the clubhouse premises must be prepared and served by the staff. All Members and visitors must at all times adhere to the liquor laws of the Province of Ontario. Visiting boaters may consume alcohol on their boat and in picnic areas.

Smoking and vaping are not allowed inside the clubhouse. Designated smoking/vaping areas are posted outside the building, where receptacles are placed for the disposal of cigarette butts. Please help us keep our property and our waters clean. Cannabis products in any form are not allowed on the Club property.

Dress Code:

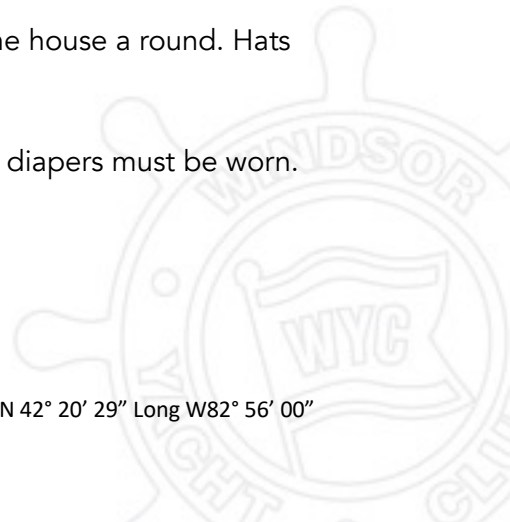
All areas of the Club, including the patio and pool, require appropriate attire. Clear communication will be provided before any event where a different dress code is necessary.

Windsor Yacht Club maintains a casual atmosphere, allowing jeans and shorts in the bar and Spinnaker Grill area. However, it is discouraged to wear them in the main dining rooms. Denim wear is generally acceptable but must be in good condition, without rips, tears, frayed ends, or holes, and should be worn appropriately.

Please refrain from wearing bathing suits, cover-ups, tank tops (for men), or other beach attire in the clubhouse and patio.

As part of our tradition, men wearing hats will be kindly asked to buy the house a round. Hats should not be worn in any area of the Clubhouse.

Swimming attire is limited to the pool area. For babies, swimmer-brand diapers must be worn.

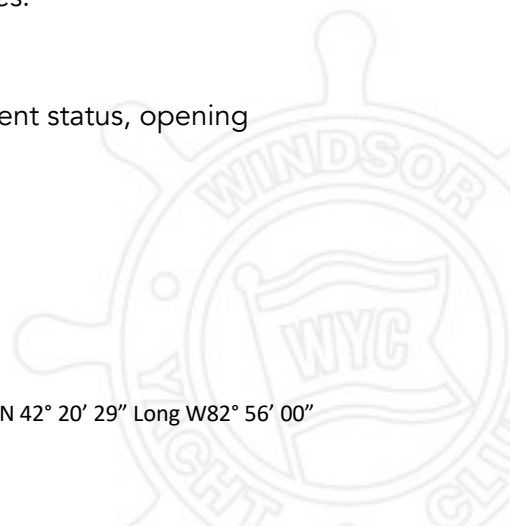

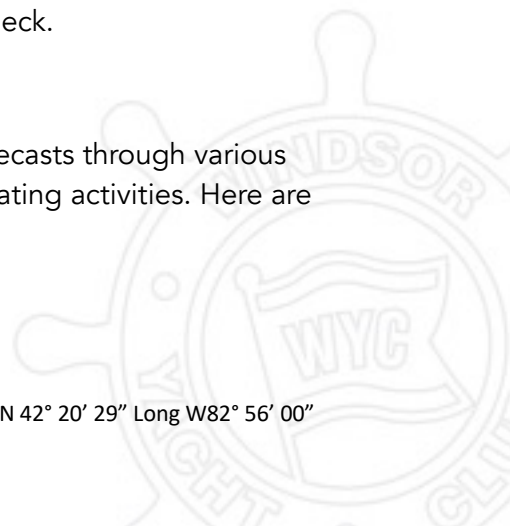
